SONG

Cotton and wool combine in this luxurious yarn with excellent stitch definition in a sophisticated palette. Perfect for year round wear, babies to adults, in cables, lace, colorwork or plain stockinette. Song does it all beautifully!

A wrap in two colors, worked from end to end with short rows sections.

SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approx 69" long and 18½" wide at center.

YARN

Song by **Classic Elite Yarns**

(50% cotton, 50% wool;

50 g = approx 110 yards)

A – 5 balls 2575 Gray

B – 2 balls 2516 Ecru

NEEDLES

Knitting needles in size US6 (4 mm) or size to obtain gauge.

GAUGE

20 sts and 40 rows = 4" in Garter stitch, blocked. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**



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ABBREVIATIONS

approx: approximately

beg: begin(ning)

CO: cast on

dec('d): decrease(d)

inc('d): increase(d)

k: knit

kfb: knit into the front and back of same st (1 st increased)

k2tog: knit 2 sts together (1 st decreased)

meas: measure(s)

pc(s): piece(s)

rem: remaining

rep(s): repeat(s)

RS: right side

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

PATTERN STITCH

Garter stitch: Knit all sts, all rows.

NOTES

Since garter stitch is reversible, it may be helpful to place a removable marker on the right side of work to differentiate right side from wrong side. When working short rows, work stitch before and after turning tightly to maintain a smooth transition line between colors. It is not necessary to wrap and turn on short rows as the turning point is hidden in the garter ridges.

WRAP

Section 1

With A, CO 2 sts.

Next row (RS): Kfb, k1 – 3 sts.

Next row (WS): K3.

***Inc row (RS):** Knit until 2 sts rem, kfb, k1 – 1 st inc'd.

Knit 3 rows.

Rep from * 26 times more – 30 sts.

110 rows worked – Pc meas approx 11" from beg (meas along the straight edge).

Section 2

Set up short rows (RS): Knit until 1 st rem, turn.

Next row (WS): knit to end.

Work short rows:

*Row 1 (RS): Knit until 1 st rem before gap from previous turn, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to end.

Rep from * until all sts are unworked, ending with a WS row – 30 sts. Break yarn.

60 rows worked – Pc meas approx 17" from beg (meas along straight edge)

Section 3

Join B, ready to work a RS row.

Set up rows Inc short rows:

Row 1 (RS): Knit across all sts until 2 sts rem, kfb, k1 – 1 st inc'd.

Row 2 (WS): K2, turn.

Row 3 (RS): K2.

Work inc short rows:

*Row 1 (WS): Knit until 1 st past gap from previous turn, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Knit until 2 sts rem, kfb, k1 – 1 st inc'd.

Row 3 (WS): Knit until 1 st past gap from previous turn, turn.

Row 4 (RS): Knit to end.

Rep from * until all sts have been worked, ending with a RS row – 46 sts.

Pc still meas approx 17" (meas along straight edge).

Section 4

Set up dec short rows:

Rows 1 (WS): Knit until 1 st rem, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Knit to end.

Work dec short rows:

*Row 1 (WS): Knit until 1 st rem before gap from previous turn, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Knit until 2 sts rem, kfb, k1 – 1 st inc'd.

Row 3 (WS): Knit until 1 st rem before gap from previous turn, turn.

Row 4 (RS): Knit to end.

Rep from * until all sts are unworked, ending with Row 2. Break yarn.



Section 5

Join A ready to work a WS and knit all sts.

Set up inc short rows:

Row 1 (RS): K1, turn.

Row 2 (WS): K1.

Work inc short rows:

*Row 1 (RS): Knit 1 st past gap made from previous turn, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to end.

Rep from * until all sts have been worked, ending with a WS row – 92 sts.

Pc meas approx 34½", (meas along straight edge). This is the halfway point.

Section 6

Set up dec short rows:

*Row 1 (RS): Knit until 1 st rem, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to end.

Rep from * until all sts are unworked, ending with a WS row.

Work dec short rows:

*Row 1 (RS): Knit until 1 st rem before gap made from previous turn, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to end.

Rep from * until all sts are unworked, ending with a WS row.

Pc meas approx 52", (meas along straight edge). Break yarn.

Section 7

Join B.

Set up rows inc short rows:

Row 1 (RS): Knit until 2 sts rem, k2tog – 1 st dec'd.

Row 2 (WS): K2, turn.

Row 3 (RS): Knit to end.

Work inc short rows:

*Row 1 (WS): Knit until 1 st past gap from previous turn, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Knit until 2 sts rem, k2tog – 1 st dec'd.

Row 3 (WS): Knit until 1 st past gap from previous turn, turn.

Row 4 (RS): Knit to end.

Rep from * until all sts have been worked, ending with Row 2 – 46 sts.

Pc still meas approx 52" (meas along straight edge).

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Section 8

Set up dec short rows:

*Row 1 (WS): Knit until 1 st rem before end, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Knit to end.

Work dec short rows:

*Row 1 (WS): Knit until 1 st rem before gap made from previous turn, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Knit until 2 sts rem, k2tog – 1 st dec'd.

Row 3 (WS): Knit until 1 st rem before gap made from previous turn, turn.

Row 4 (RS): Knit to end.

Rep from * until all sts are unworked, ending with Row 2.

Section 9

Join A ready to work a WS and knit all sts.

Set up Inc short rows:

Row 1 (RS): K1, turn.

Row 2 (WS): K1.

Work Inc short rows:

*Row 1 (RS): Knit until 1 st past gap from previous turn, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to end.

Rep from * until all sts have been worked, ending with a RS row.

Pc meas approx 58" (meas along straight edge).

Section 10

Tapered end:

*Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Row 2 (RS): Knit until 2 sts rem, k2tog.

Rows 3 and 4: Knit.

Rep from * until 1 st rem.

Fasten off.
