ESCAPE

This summer-friendly yarn combines fine merino (20 microns), mulberry silk and yak in a single ply of pure luxury. The six sophisticated shades of this dk weight have a slight heathered look from the darker undyed yak fibers. With incredible softness and good stitch definition, Escape is a go-to luxury yarn at a less than luxury price.

SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50½" circumference x 10" high

YARN

Escape by **Classic Elite Yarns**
(75% fine merino, 15% yak, 10% mulberry silk; 50 g = 130 yards)
4 balls 2657 Aero
1 ball 2616 Natural

NEEDLES

Circular knitting needle (24 or 32") in size US 4 and 5 (3.5 and 3.75 mm) **or size to obtain gauge.**

OTHER MATERIALS

Stitch markers

GAUGE

22 sts and 42 rows = 4" in Seed St with larger needle. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

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PATTERN STITCH

Seed Stitch - in the Round (odd number of sts)

Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * and end k1.

Rnd 2: *P1, k1; rep from * and end p1.

Rep rnds 1 and 2 for Seed Stitch.

COWL

With A and larger needle, CO 279 sts. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Pm for BOR.

Work in Seed Stitch for 4".

Change to smaller needle and join B.

Knit 1 rnd with B, purl 1 rnd with A: rep from until pc meas approx 7".

With A and larger needle, work in Seed Stitch until pc meas approx 10".
BO all sts loosely in Seed Stitch (use a larger needle if necessary).

FINISHING

Block lightly to measurements, taking care not to flatten texture.
Weave in ends.

BO: bind off

BOR: beginning of round

CO: cast on

k: knit

meas: measure(s)

p: purl

pc: piece

pm: place marker

rep: repeat

rnd(s): round(s)

st(s): stitch(es)
